Arturo:

1. Score - 1. "My name of..." is not grammatically correct.
2. Score - 1. Answer is not given in a complete sentence.
3. Score - 1. Answer is not given in a complete sentence.
4. Score - 1. Answer is not given in a complete sentence.
5. Story score - 3. Speech is a basic description of the prompt using 2 - 3 sentences. Lack of details or complex sentence structures keep the speech from earning a rating of 4.

Oscar:

1. Score - 2. Student provided appropriate, complete sentence.
2. Score - 2. Student provided appropriate, complete sentence.
3. Score - 2. Student provided appropriate, complete sentence.
4. Score - 2. Student provided appropriate, complete sentence.
5. Story Score - 4. Speech is a detailed description of the picture prompt with a few errors. It is not a 5 because of awkward phrasing and vocabulary not typical of a native English speaker, such as "putting their hands both on the ground and putting their legs on top."

Eduardo:

1. Score - 0. Response was not appropriate to the question.
2. Score - 1. Answer is not given in a complete sentence.
3. Score - 1. Answer is not given in a complete sentence
4. Score - 0. Response was not appropriate to the question.
5. Story Score - 0. No response was given.

Dulce:

Story Score - 2. Response includes 3 basic sentences related to the prompt. Most sentences include errors. Response does not rate a score of 3 because there is no sequence or indicator of a story, and student only responded with minimal speech to questions given by the examiner.

Liliana:

Story Score - 3. Response gives a basic story. Response does not rate a 4 because few details are given and vocabulary is not descriptive. Speech also includes a few grammatical errors, but errors do not affect meaning.
